Rock-Splitting Cherry Tree This cherry tree which has split and grew out of a huge rock is located outside Morioka District Court. It is 11m in height and around 350-400 years old. It is designated as a natural treasure of Japan.



Chagu Chagu Umako Horse Parade This festival is unique to the old Nanbu region of Morioka which has been a horse-rearing region from long ago where horses are cherished.

**Mt. Iwate and the Kitakami River** The view of Mt. Iwate and the Kitakami River from Kaiun-bashi Bridge is superb.

# When cycling along Morioka Odori Shopping Arcade:

Cycle in the blue zone

(on the blue markings on the road)

Cycle on the left hand side of the road

in the direction that you want to go in







Additionally, please follow the rules below when cycling along Morioka Odori Shopping Arcade.



- Watch out for doors of nearby cars opening and closing.
- $\cdot$  Be sure to get off your bicycle and push it

when on the sidewalk.



- Definitely do not cycle on the right hand side of the road (traffic violation).
- You can't ride your bicycle on the sidewalk.

\*Except for people of 70 and over or under 13 and when it is unavoidable for safety reasons.

#### The pedestrian paradise of Morioka Odori Shopping Arcade

#### What is a pedestrian paradise?

It's a road that only pedestrians can pass along.

(At specified times and on specific days) only pedestrians can pass along the road.

From April to October every Sunday and on public holidays between 11:00am and 6:00pm, Morioka Odori Shopping Arcade is a pedestrian paradise. (From November to March, you can drive your car along the shopping arcade as usual.)
